#### **(6) MONTENEGRO**

Enjoy the drive around the Kotor Bay with its numerous small settlements; stop in Medieval Kotor to soak in the typical Mediterranean lifestyle; continue high up into the mountains to visit Cetinje, once the seat of the Montenegrin rulers; stroll around in Budva, the ancient town which is today a lively tourist resort.

## **(7) ANCIENT MONTENEGRO**

Nowhere else can you find, in such a small area, so much natural beauty interlaced with such a rich historical and cultural heritage like in Montenegro. Mild beaches, clear waters and gorgeous mountains that plunge into the sea will greet you upon your arrival to the Gulf of Kotor. Ringed in the mountains, the innermost bays of the Gulf, Risan and Kotor, are the earliest inhabited areas with evidences of civilization dating from Illyrian, Roman and early Christian periods. In our quest for traces and memories of past times, we will be visiting the town of Risan with a Roman villa and its exceptionally well preserved mosaics from the 2d and 3d century AD; a short boat ride from the baroque shore town of Perast will take us to one of the two islets in the Bay to visit the Church of Our Lady of the Rocks with one of the finest collections of wall paintings in this part of Europe. In the UNESCO-protected town of Kotor enjoy a guided tour through one of the best preserved medieval old towns on the Adriatic and visit the 12th century Cathedral of St Tryphon with its wonderful collection of sacral art. And finally, enjoy the opportunity to make your own memories during your free time in Kotor!

## **(8) A TASTE OF DALMATIA**

**This excursion really gives you the chance to TASTE Dalmatia.**

In the charming village of Orašac take part in the production of olive oil in the old fashioned way, where the «mill» is driven by a horse. This trip through time will certainly delight you. Here you will also have the opportunity to taste some home made cheese, smoked ham and wine. All this in an old fashioned house which has not changed much through the ages. In the times of the Dubrovnik Republic, Ston was the second most important town. Its wealth was derived from the salt works that are still in function today. Although being known for the spectacular city walls, that are considered to be the second longest in the world, today this region is predominantly known as the «oyster capital» of Croatia. Here you will be served a nice sea food platter (octopus, mussels, small fish and an oyster). Finally we will pay a visit to one of the best known wine producers of the region. The Pelješac peninsula has for ages been known for its excellent wines. And the Miloš family wine cellar is today certainly one of the foremost representatives of this production. During the visit to the cellar a pleasant wine tasting will be organized.

Don't miss the opportunity to experience the old mills on the river Ljuta once used to grind corn and produce flour as well as for fine processing of cloths. Enjoy a demonstration and a welcome drink and snack. Once an ancient Greek and Roman town, today Cavtat is one of the most beautiful small settlements along the Adriatic coast. Join your guide for a short orientational sightseeing and later enjoy some time on your own discovering this charming town. And finally before ending this eventful day we will make a stop at the mountain viewpoint which offers a spectacular view at the whole area including the surrounding islands.

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#### **(15) CAVTAT WALKING TOUR**

Cavtat is the most southern town in Croatia and Cavtat area is most attractive because of the Mediterranean vegetation which covers the whole area; another advantage is unpolluted sea and a very attractive mixture of old and new architecture. Originally it was a Greek settlement called Epidaurus. Around 228 BC it was under the Romans and later became a Roman colony. The name Cavtat originates from Civets vet us, as the fugitives in the newly established Dubrovnik used to call their first habitation. Guests will be guided by Elite Travel expert guide, who will introduce them with the culture and the history of this beautiful small town. No entrance fees included.
